Background and experience The Jožef Stefan Technical School is a five-year secondary school in Trieste, where the language of instruction is Slovenian. Since its foundation in 1978, the school has provided students with scientific and technological education closely linked to the world of work. In addition to professional training, the school also focuses on developing linguistic skills in both the mother tongue and foreign languages, primarily by promoting its international dimension. It offers three main educational specializations: Electronics and Electrotechnics Chemistry, Materials, and Biotechnology Mechanics and Mechatronics	

Erasmus+ and International Projects

The school is in contact with local schools and it actively undertakes cross-border activities with schools in Slovenia and Croatia. In 2013-14 it cooperated with Lasnamäe Mehaanikakool in Tallinn, Estonia within the Leonardo project.

During 2011-2019 it regularly hosted AIESEC university students for six week internships each year.

In 2018-23 the school was a partner in two consecutive Erasmus+ KA229 projects with Rudbeckgymnasiet Natural Science School in Örebro, Sweden.

From 2023 to 2025, the school led its own KA122 Erasmus+ project, *Eureka: Electronics and Mechatronics across Europe*. The project included short-term student mobility and job-shadowing experiences for three teachers. The school partnered with IES Profesor Antonio Cabrera Pérez in Telde, Spain for student mobility, and with IES Alpajés (Aranjuez, Spain) and Zespół Szkół Elektrycznych (Poland) for job-shadowing activities.

The project was highly successful, scoring 100 out of 100, and was recognized as an example of good practice, with evaluators recommending its dissemination across European schools through partnerships and networks.

Additionally, in 2023-2025, the school participated in two KA210 partnerships:

KA210SCH – *Innovative International Library Creativity* (with SGLZŠ, Slovenia, and Knjižnica Šmarje pri Jelšah, Slovenia).

KA210VET – *Adriatic Networking and Cooperation* (ANAC) with partners from Slovenia and Croatia.

Since 2024, Jožef Stefan Technical School has been an **Erasmus+ KA120 accredited school in school education**.

In 2023-2024 four individual student mobilities were carried out in the fields of electronics and biochemistry at the Department of Electronics and Aquaculture of IES Profesor Antonio Cabrera Pérez in Telde, Spain. Additionally, a group mobility for biochemistry students was organized, and two teachers participated in professional development mobilities, attending language and CLIL courses in Dublin, Ireland, and Ponta Delgada, Portugal.

In 2025-2026 we strengthened our online eTwinning collaboration with IES Alpajés through the joint project *INTO4IR* (Innovative Teaching of the 4th Industrial Revolution) and implemented a group mobility of electronics and mechanics students to Aranjuez, Spain. We also collaborated on the project *Pure Water, Clear Future* with Rudbeckgymnasiet Natural Science School in Örebro, Sweden, completing a student group mobility and one job-shadowing activity.

Student Profile and Inclusive Education

The school serves 153 students aged 14-19 from Trieste, Gorizia, and surrounding areas. The student body is diverse, with most students coming from Slovenian or Slovenian-Italian families, while some have Italian backgrounds. Some students speak other languages at home. However, most are part of a Slovenian community context, making them fluent in both Slovenian and Italian.

The school provides support for students with linguistic or socio-cultural difficulties and those recognized as athletes or artists. It offers individualized adaptations in the teaching and learning process to ensure an inclusive and supportive learning environment for all.

Student Development and Community Engagement

The school emphasizes the holistic development of students, integrating science, technology, ethical values, arts, and culture into its curriculum. It promotes volunteerism and solidarity, working with organizations such as:

ABC association for hospitalized children, St. Egidio Community, Blood donation programs, first aid, BLS courses, and food charity campaigns. For Earth Day 2023, the school launched several initiatives to raise awareness of environmental issues and encourage environmental protection, including a cleanup campaign.

Through drama, film, poetry, and creative workshops, the school fosters a creative mindset and strengthens students' cultural awareness. It also conducts annual intercultural initiatives to explore the multi-religious and multicultural aspects of Trieste, raise awareness of local cultural heritage (FAI project, EHD), and engage in literary competitions, theatre, cinema, and art exhibitions.
